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TAX NOTIFICATION INFORMATION

The pension payments you receive from the Dresser, Inc. Consolidated Salaried Retirement Plan will be subject to federal income tax withholding unless you elect not to have withholding apply. (Withholding will only apply to the portion of your pension payment that is already included in your income subject to federal income tax and will be like wage withholding. Thus, there will be no withholding on the return of your own nondeductible contributions to the Plan, if any.)

Your election will remain in effect until you revoke it. You may revoke your election at any time by returning the signed and dated revocation to Dresser, Inc. Any election or revocation will be effective no later than the first of the month following the 30-day period after your election or revocation is received. You may make and revoke elections not to have withholding apply as often as you wish. Additional elections may be obtained from Dresser, Inc.

If you do not return the election by the first of the month prior to your pension payment start date, federal income tax will be withheld from the taxable portion of your pension payments as if you were a married individual claiming three withholding allowances.

If you elect not to have withholding apply to your pension payments, or if you do not have enough federal income tax withheld from your pension payments, you will be responsible for payment of estimated tax. Penalties may be assessed under the estimated tax rules if your withholding and estimated tax payments are not sufficient.
